Miksi Mix? The Why Mix?

What is Auraco's new work made of? Mime, dance, music. Mazes, circles, spirals. Emojis of three wise monkeys. That's what The Why Mix is made of.

The word "why" is key to understanding and knowledge. "Mix" is a mixture. The Why Mix throws up questions about the meanings and interpretations of bodily movement. The Why Mix is a geometric, thrilling, colourful and partly serious mixture of contemporary dance, mime and music. The piece questions how children's bodily expression and movements have been constricted and reduced in this era of smartphones and emojis.

Orpheus' Comfort and Amor's Ease

In September 2020, Babyopera premiered two new performances parallel within the frame of one production - Orpheus' Comfort and Amor's Ease - both operas for babies. One includes an original aria from the opera Orfeo ed Euridice by Gluck, the other opera includes a fragment from the opera King Arthur by Purcell The audience is taken back to the Baroque period in this piece, which works from a basis of opera's potential to excite, comfort and create a state of wonder.

The performance explores the human and the all-too-human, with fun, colour, profundity and some nonsense. It's full of associated imagery, shifting layers of music and idiosyncratic play, intending to bring joy and pleasure to its audience.

WE MADE ITI is a festival which puts children's agency at its centre. The entire program, from the choice of artistic shows to the themes that will be discussed in the Chatting Circles, goes through the scrutiny of the Children's Committee, formed by children between 9 and 12 years old, who sign up in advance to create and plan the festival.

This means the child is at the centre of the creative process, active in decision-making, taking responsibility and making autonomous choices. They aren't just spectators, they have become the authors and directors by giving their opinions, discussing, choosing and enjoying an event that they helped to create.

EXHIBITION ACTIVITIES ARE ONE OF THE FOCUSES OF THE CENTRES: VANTAA'S CHILDREN'S CULTURE PRODUCES ITS OWN TOURING EXHIBITIONS AND COLLABORATES ON EXHIBITION EXCHANGES.

Tuntupolku The Path of Senses

The Path of Senses is an exhibition and experiential space divided into four colour areas, based on the four seasons. The exhibition provides babies and toddlers with experiences of different surfaces, textures, materials, and colours. The Path of Senses also creates an opportunity for child and adult interaction. Many things that are completely familiar to adults are wonderful and interesting for a small person. The Path of Senses is a beautiful space, artistically planned and executed by Heli Arvilommi.


